Basic Requirements

- Complete an assessment of physical capabilities
- Attend volunteer orientation
- Have a TB test during orientation
- Have hospital/department training in the area to be worked
- Adhere to volunteer uniform or dress standards
- Adhere to "Code of Conduct"
- Be punctual and reliable, displaying dignity, courtesy and consideration for others
- Volunteers cannot directly participate in or observe patient care without patient consent

Additional Requirements for Adult Volunteers

Because the safety of our employees, patients and other volunteers is a priority, a criminal background check is required for Adult Volunteers (paid for by the hospital).

If you are looking for a change, a challenge or new friends, volunteering at Flowers Hospital may be the place for you to make a difference.

Additional Requirements for Teen Volunteers (ages 14-17)

Teens must have a drug screening (paid for by the hospital) before placement begins.
